The Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held to hear the reports of the Board of Directors and Program Managers, review the Corporation's financial reports and to conduct other Corporation business as is deemed necessary. AGM is one of two corporate meetings held each year along with the June Special Corporate Meeting. Elections for various Board positions are also held at these meetings.

The primary business at this year's AGM will be elections for the following Board positions up for 2-year terms in 2022:

- Vice President
- Treasurer
- Registrar
- Equipment Coordinator

Anyone in good standing with USA (as well as with MAYS, Mass Youth Soccer (MYSA), and US Youth Soccer) may be nominated for a position. You do **not** need to be a coach to be on the board and can self-nominate for any of these positions. For job descriptions, go [here](#).

All coaches from the prior calendar year in good standing are considered voting members, and may cast a vote at these meetings for Board positions and any other voting items on the agenda.

Each team is limited to 2 votes, so if there are more than two coaches from one team planning to attend, you will need to decide which two will vote. If there is a dispute, the Director of Programs will make the final decision, per our bylaws (though no one can remember this actually ever happening).
