Parents, Players, Coaches and Volunteers of United Soccer of Auburn:

As week one has completed it is safe to say that we are returning to fall soccer under most unusual circumstances. To all who have read, responded and complied with the new restrictions, we sincerely thank you, abiding by the regulations is essential and non-negotiable.

After this past weekend, we did observe some behavior that requires us to repeat the following rules for all games and practices:

- 1) Each player is allowed **one (1) adult** spectator at each game. Children will count towards the spectator limits. It is encouraged to find alternate childcare; however, we know this is not always possible. If you need to bring a child and the field capacity is reached you may be asked to depart
- 2) Every spectator & player must wear a mask at all times at the field, from the time you leave your car to the time you return to your car. Players at all time, except when six (6) or more feet from another player for a “mask break” to catch their breath, drink, or eat, must wear face coverings.
- 3) Every spectator must maintain a social distance of at least 6 feet from any other spectator

***If found to be in violation of these, rules you and/or your player(s) will be immediately and indefinitely suspended from participating in any United Soccer of Auburn activities until an outcome from a hearing.***

We are currently under orders to comply with these regulations by several governing bodies:

- Massachusetts Youth Soccer (the state governing body)
- Midland Area Youth Soccer (MAYS – our immediate parent league)
- Town of Auburn Board of Health
- The Massachusetts Executive Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs

There are representatives from these organizations monitoring the situations at games across the league.
